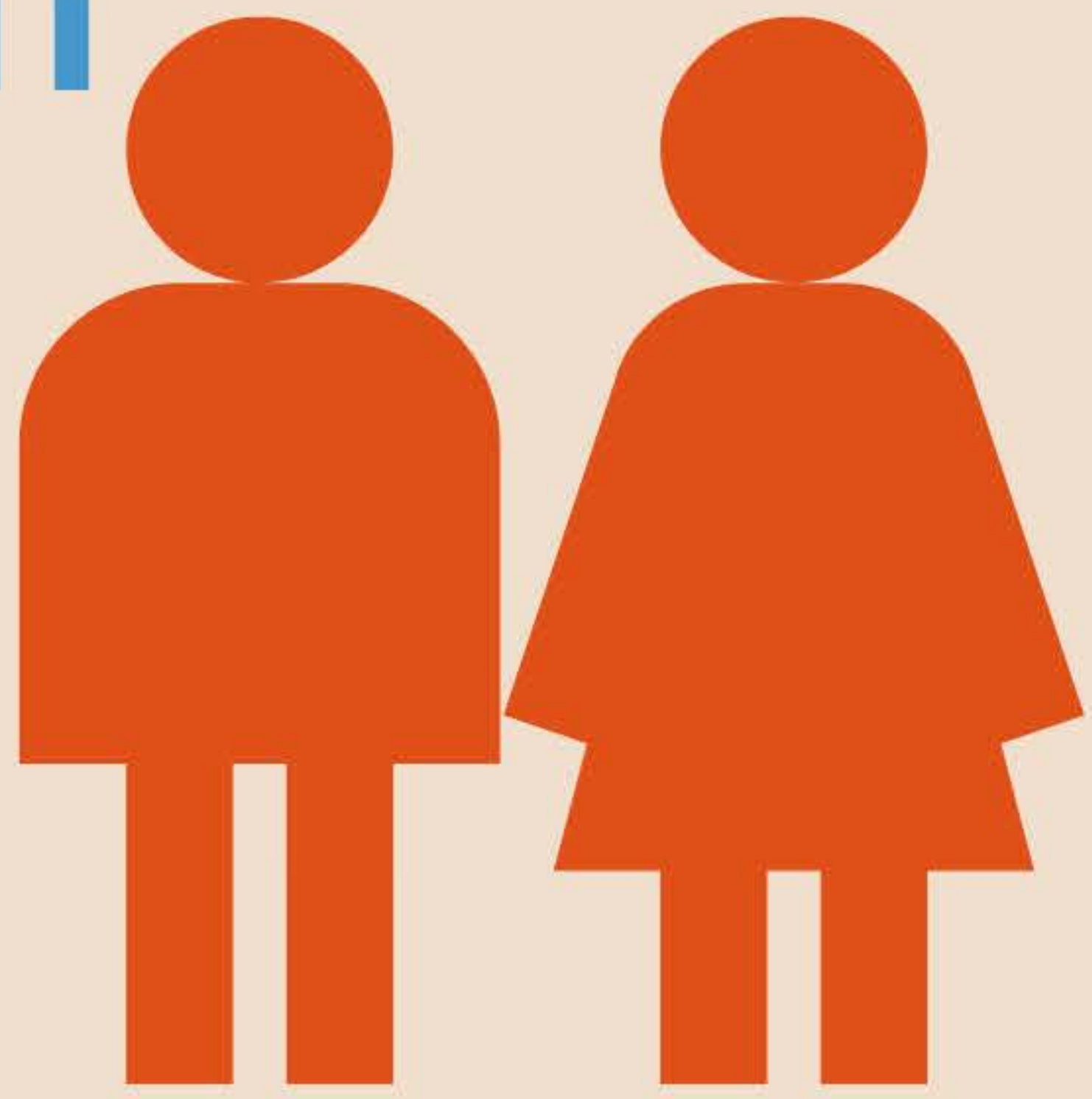

Civilian Labor Force

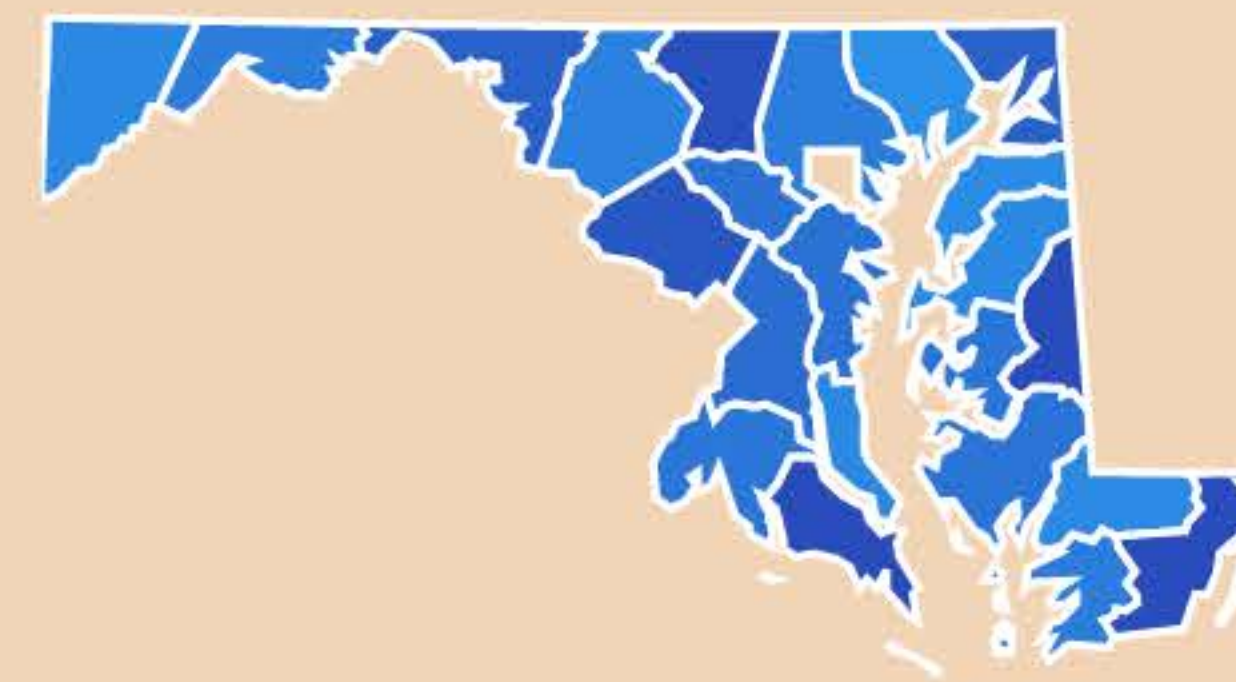
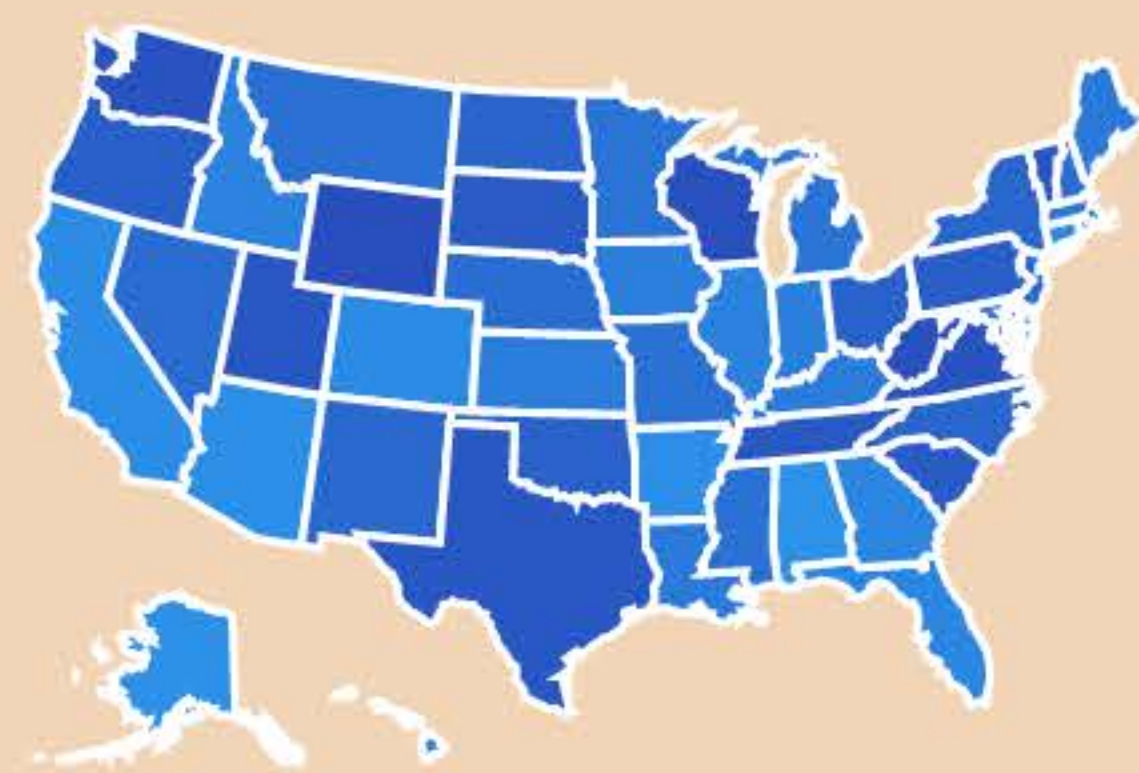
