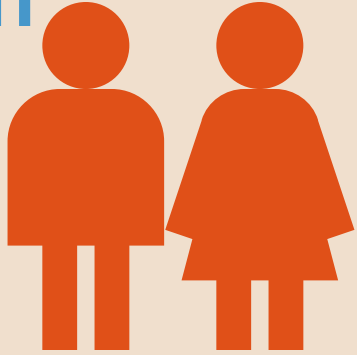

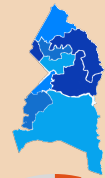
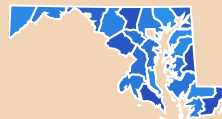
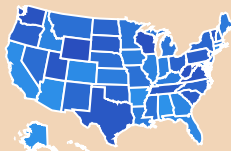
Civilian Labor Force
