Our Business Services team can help you create and develop your own talent pipeline by training job seekers or up training your existing staff.

Our Services Include:

- Funds for training WIOA eligible participants that include:
 - *On-the-job training: Seventy-five percent (75%) reimbursement of base wage for up to 6 months*
 - *Customized Training: Reimbursement for training entry-level clients in skills required for your positions*
 - *Funds available for training full-time incumbent workers who have been employed with your company for six (6) months or longer*
- Recruitment, screening, and matching for clients who are enrolled in training or have graduated from skills training
- Re-employment for dislocated workers

Connect with Incentive Programs

Increase your revenue by utilizing money-saving incentives on wages and taxes through special workforce programs.

- Business Services staff will screen applicants for available State and Federal Tax Credit Programs such as the Work Opportunity Tax Credit, the Employment Opportunity Credit, and the Enterprise Zone Tax Credit.
- If you are receiving Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Incentives, the Prince George's County American Job Centers can assist in recruiting low to moderate-income applicants.
